Author Guidelines

Structure of the Paper

Your paper should be organized as follows:

- 1. Title
- 2. Author names and affiliations
- 3. Abstract (max 250 words)
- 4. Keywords (3-5)
- 5. Main text Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion
- 6. Conclusions
- 7. Acknowledgments (if applicable)
- 8. References

Technical Formatting

File format: Microsoft Word (.docx)

Page size: A4

Maximum length: 12 pages total, including the main text, figures, tables, and references Recommended length for main text: Approximately 6 pages, corresponding to 24,000–

25,000 characters with spaces

Font: Helvetica, 11 pt Line spacing: 1.15

Margins: 2.5 cm on all sides

Paragraphs: Justified alignment, no indentation

Headings: Use a consistent hierarchy (Heading 1, Heading 2, Heading 3)

Figures and Tables

- Insert directly into the text, close to the point of first mention
- Number sequentially (Figure 1, Table 1)
- Place figure captions below and table captions above
- All figures/tables must be cited in the text
- Minimum resolution: 300 dpi
- Accepted formats if submitted separately: .jpg, .png, .tiff

Referencing Style

All references must follow the APA (7th edition) referencing style.

Include a list of references under the heading References. Use in-text citations in the form (Kucera & Fitz, 1995). Use hanging indentation in the reference list. Include DOI links where available. Do not number references.

Example:
